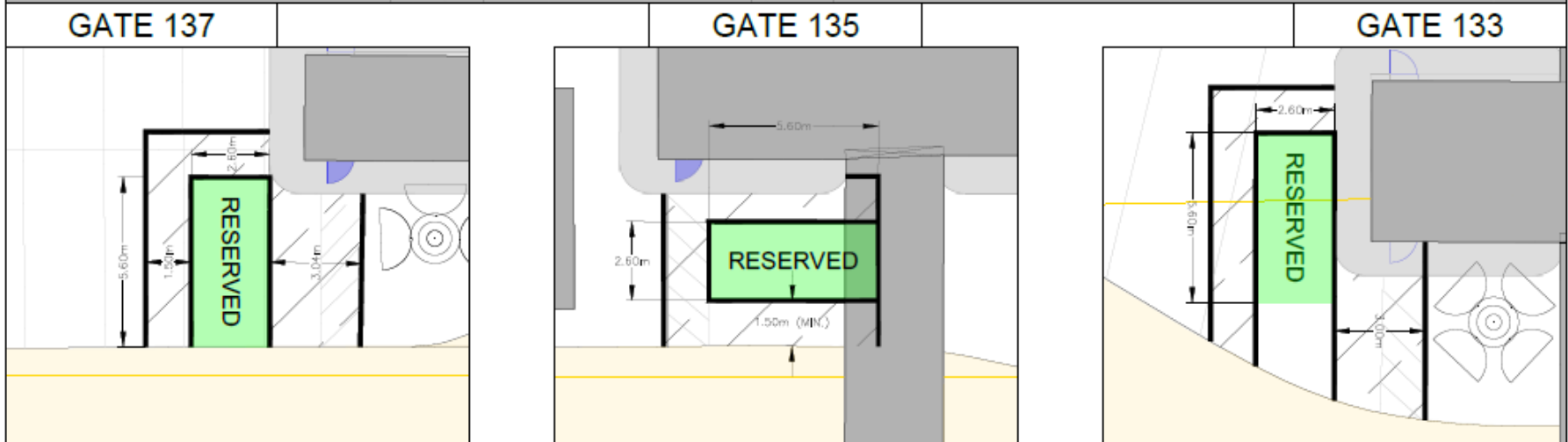
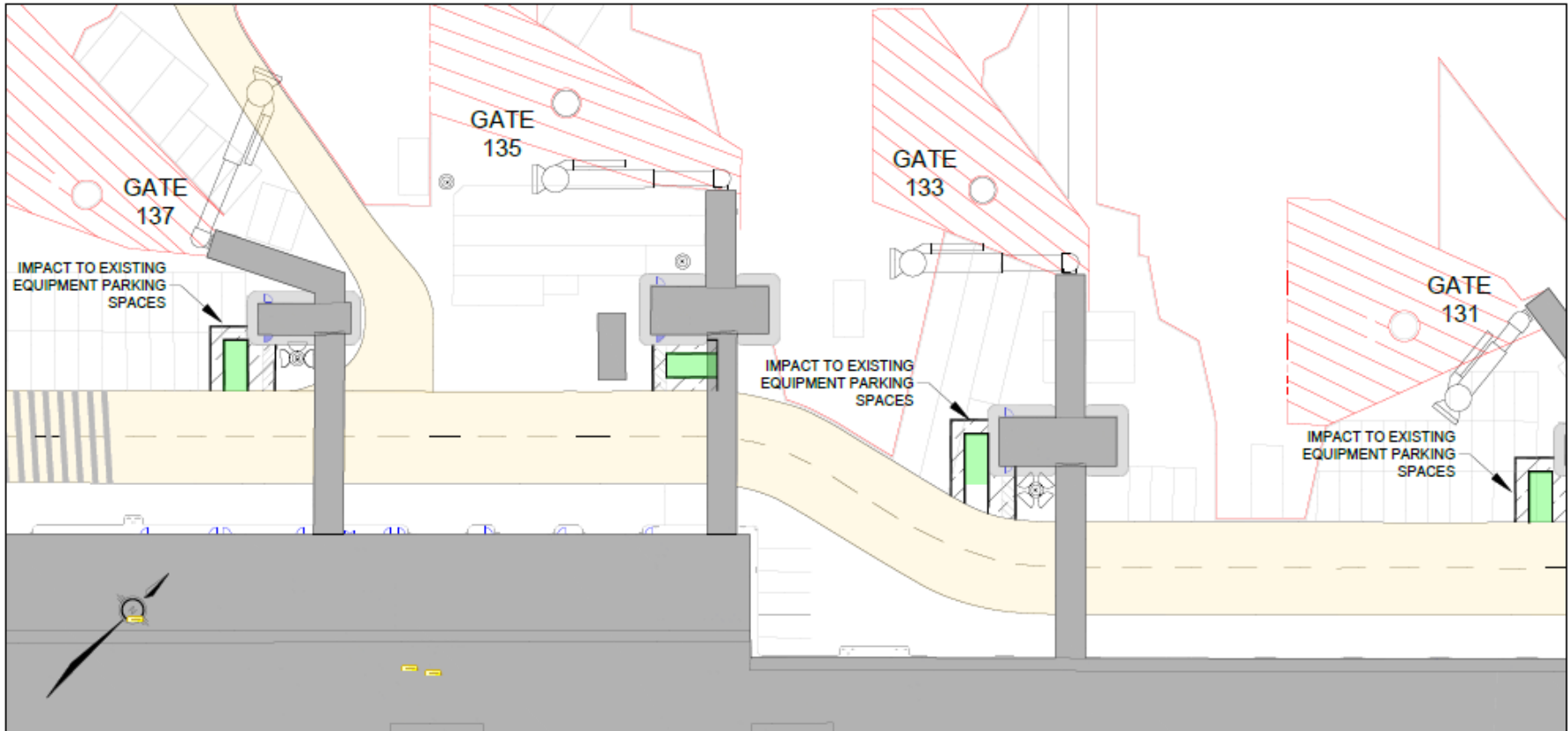
There are new vehicle stalls marked RESERVED at certain Terminal 1 Domestic gates that will be used for an airline's expanded airside car service for premium passengers, beginning January 8, 2019.

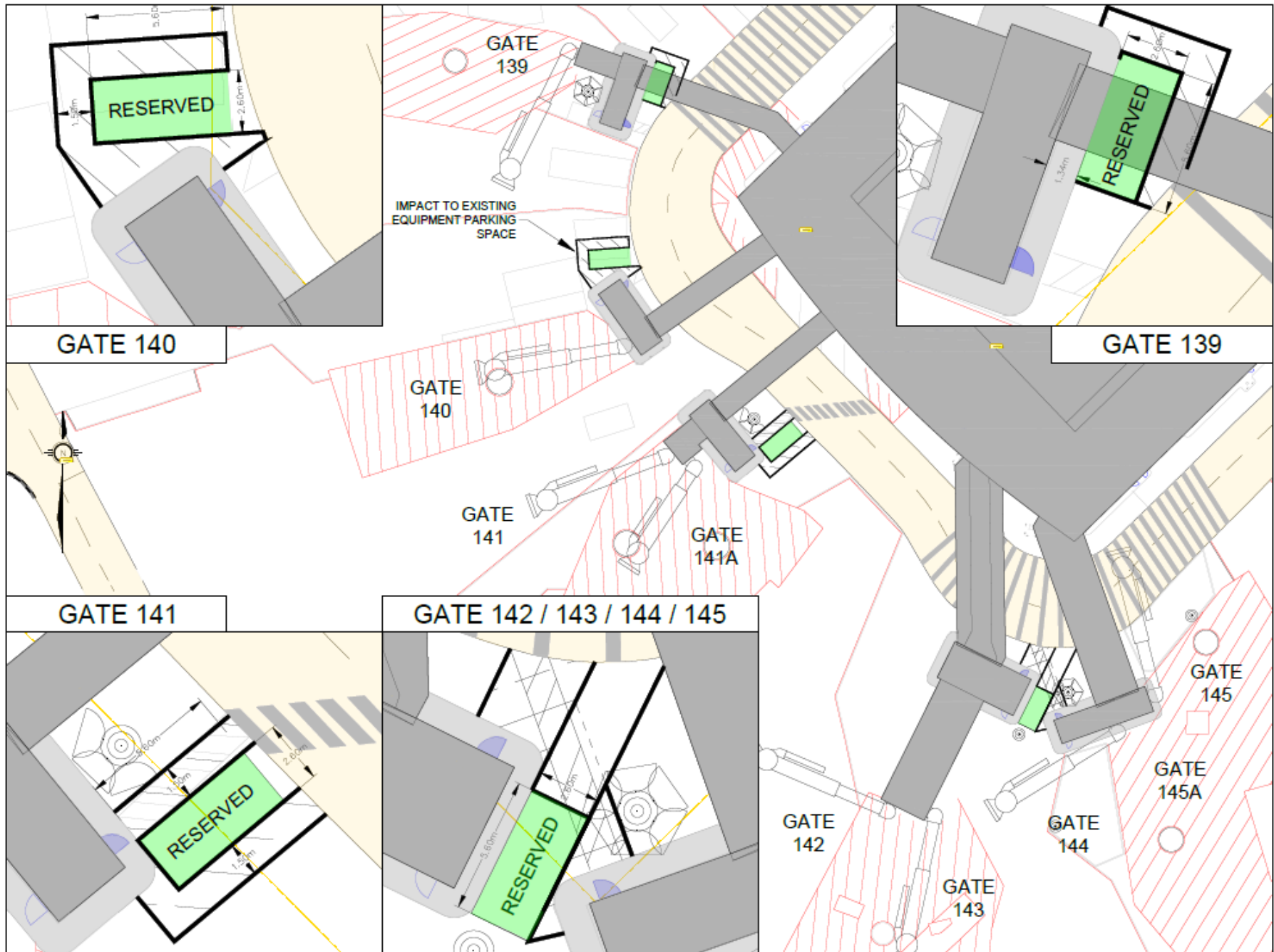
The emergency exit stairwells at these gates have been modified to allow only designated airline staff and emergency responders to access the bridge. These doors should not be blocked by vehicles or equipment. The reserved stalls are the designated staging locations for vehicles to pick up the passengers upon their arrival. Passenger path lines are marked around each stall to indicate the safe zone for passengers to transit to the vehicle as they will not be wearing high-visibility safety vests; they will be under escort at all times by the airside car driver wearing a high-visibility safety vest.

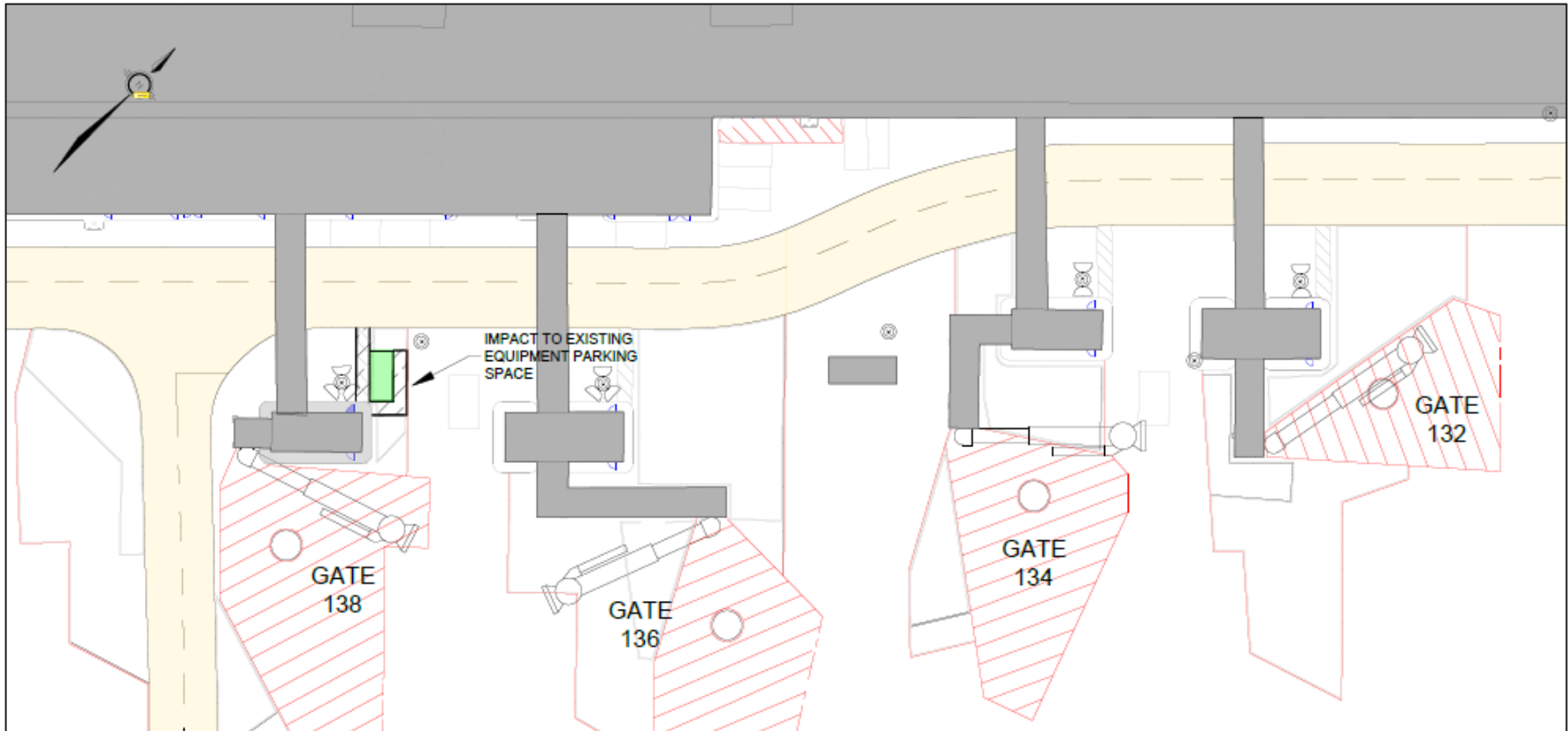
With this expanded airside car service, there will be an increase in traffic on the head-of-stand road with passengers in addition to the International-to-Domestic (ITD) and hardstand buses. Please be reminded that the speed limit for head-of-stand road is 20 km/h and exercise caution when operating or driving by these locations. Do not park on or block the RESERVED stalls. These areas will be monitored and enforced by Aviation Safety Officers (ASO).
