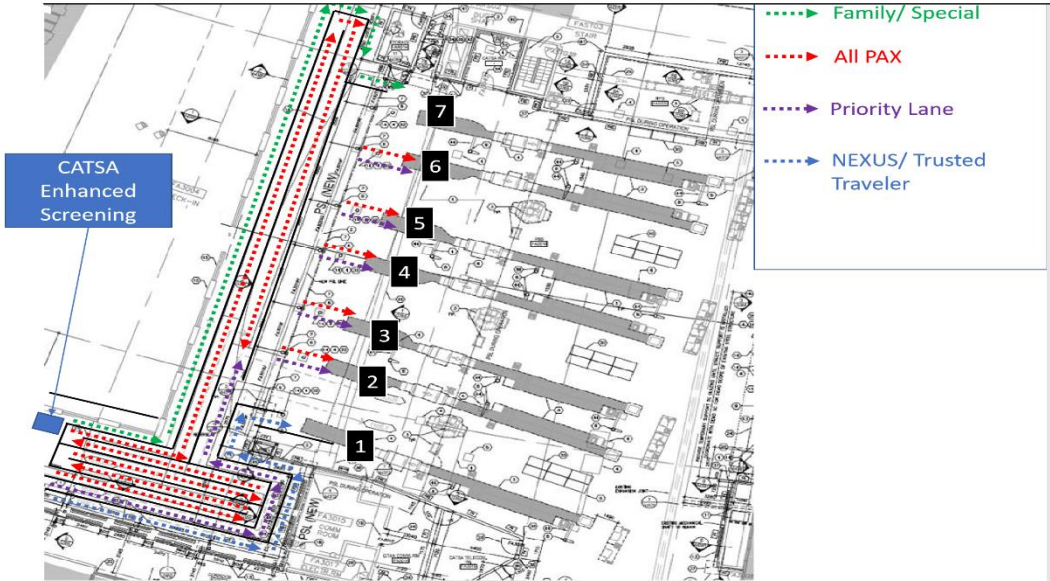

On Wednesday January 9, 2019 at 0300hrs, we will be opening and commencing operations at the new CATSA Plus International Pre-Board Screening (PBS) checkpoint in Terminal 1.

The existing International PBS checkpoint will close after the last flight (approximately 0030hrs) on Wednesday January 9, 2019. At this time, we will transition over to the new location.

The new PBS checkpoint is located where the old ITPC was previously situated, opposite Check-In Aisle 6.

On Wednesday January 9, 2019 at 0200hrs, the Non-Passenger Screening (NPS-T) checkpoint will move from the current location at Lane 1 in the existing International PBS checkpoint. The existing NPS-T will close at 0200hrs and the new NPS-T will open immediately after.

The new NPS-T is located at the north side of the new PBS checkpoint, next to the Flight Information Display (FID) monitors, opposite the Air Canada Assistance Check-In Counters at Aisle 8.
