Cargo West NPSv Work on Traffic Management System January 21-22

The Cargo West Non-Passenger Screening for Vehicles (NPSv) will undergo work on the Traffic Management System (TMS) to enhance the flow of traffic through the facility. To facilitate this work, the following temporary changes will be in effect January 21-22, 2019:

- All barrier arms are raised (open)
- One lane entrance will be closed depending on the work location as indicated by the red X at the top of the canopy entrance, traffic cones across the lane, security vehicle in the lane not in service, or a combination of the three (see diagram below)
- Restricted Area Identity Card (RAIC) verification will occur at the canopy entrance (first barrier arm). After RAIC verification, the driver will be directed to continue in the same lane for screening or to transition to the other lane to bypass
- Screening will remain at the third barrier arm. If directed through the bypass lane, the vehicle must still come to a complete stop at the third barrier arm and yield to pedestrians, when present, before proceeding through.

Workers will be present on the curb between 0600L and 1400L; please exercise caution when driving through the facility and transitioning between lanes.
